Submission Policy: CS Department Faculty approves content and inclusion in the caltechCSTR digital archive. The repository managers reviews metadata and contents prior to final deposit into the archive.

Data Policy

Contents will be openly available over the global network.

Once content is posted to the archive, it may not be withdrawn except to allow revisions via replacements with faculty approval. Revised versions will be so noted in metadata and in document.

Metadata Policy

Third parties may collect metadata from the archive via mechanisms that create end-user services to support the discovery and presentation of the archive's content. The general policy is to allow harvesting of metadata. Harvesting full content is not permitted.

Records in the archive have unique and persistent identifiers in the form:

caltechCSTR:yyyy.###

CaltechCSTR is the Repository Identifier. It is followed by a colon.

yyyy is the year the report is created. It may also be the year the report is released for open distribution in the archive, also known as the Date for Discovery, and is the first component of the Unique REPOSITORYID. It is followed by a dot.

is the paper number for that year.

Separator: **:** [colon] is the separator between the Repository Identifier and the unique number.
